How to live stream – this is important

1. Getting access to our Facebook Page

All the action takes place through our Facebook Page:

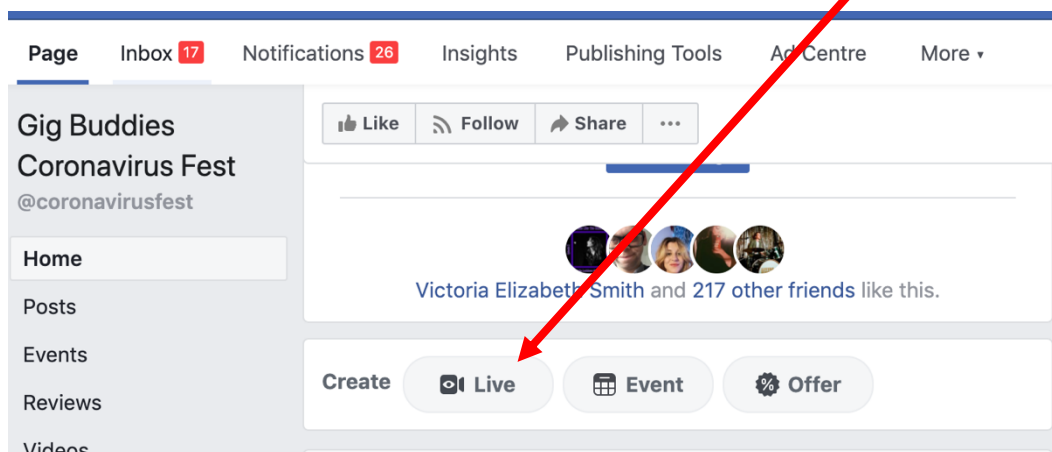

When you sign up for a slot we will ask you to send us a link to your personal Facebook profile. This is so we can make you a temporary page admin.

You will then be able to take over the page when it's your time to play.

2. Performing

When it's your time to play you need to click on the 'Create' /Live button which is at the top of the page. Then click 'Go Live' when you are ready to go.



Tips on performing

Before you do your set please check that your mic levels are high enough to hear you.

Please remember the person performing after you. If you are on the earlier slot allow 10 minutes for the next person to be ready.
